- Cake or cupcakes along with coffee and punch will be served outdoors on the lower parking level near the entrance doors. This will allow more space for people to move without congestion and let us be closer to the action of the capsule burial.
- The burial of the time capsule will take place after people have had time to enjoy refreshments.
